### Numeracy

The children will be looking at being able to; read Roman numerals to 1000 (M), recognise years written in Roman numerals, round to check answers to calculations in the context of problems, solve multi-step addition problems in contexts using RUDELY, multiply and divide numbers up to 4 digits by a one or two digit number using an efficient written method, x and ÷ whole numbers and those involving decimals by 10, 100 and 1000, recognise and use 1000ths and relate them to 10ths, hundredths and decimal equivalents, read, write, compare and order decimals with up to 3 decimal places, read and write decimals as fractions E.g. 0.71 = 71/100, convert between different units of measure E.g. kilometre to metre, metre to centimetre, centimetre and millimetre, kilogram and gram, litre and millimetre), understand and use basic equivalences between metric and common imperial units,
